Book Exercises: GRE Practice Test 1, Section 3, pp. 333 – 341.

Do these problems with no clock and no dictionary.

Look up the answers on p. 371. The “P+” score shows the percentage of students who get each problem right. For GRE verbal problems, the average is 54%, with a standard deviation of 19%.

¹ Therefore, the difficulty categories go something like this:

Easy problems: $P > 73$

Medium problems: $35 < P < 73$

Hard problems: $P < 35$

Revisit the problems you missed. Look up any words you didn't know. The higher the P score, the more concerned I am that you should be getting the problem right. Don't worry too much about the hard problems unless you are ready to crack 160.
