Do these problems with no clock and no dictionary.
Look up the answers on p. 372. The "P+" score shows the percentage of students who get each problem right. For GRE verbal problems, the average is $54 \%$, with a standard deviation of $19 \%$. ${ }^{1}$ Therefore, the difficulty categories go something like this:

Easy problems: $\mathrm{P}>73$
Medium problems: $35<\mathrm{P}<73$
Hard problems: $\mathrm{P}<35$
Revisit the problems you missed. Look up any words you didn't know. The higher the P score, the more concerned I am that you should be getting the problem right. Don't worry too much about the hard problems unless you are ready to crack 160 .
